NONPROFIT CAPACITY BUILDING GRANTS

Generally, capacity building grants are not about expanding an organization's services, adding a new program, or renovating facilities. They are about strengthening an organization's infrastructure, management, and/or governance. Through these grants, the Foundation seeks to strengthen the efficiency, effectiveness, and sustainability of organizations serving our community.

Requests may be up to \$10,000.

Projects may include strategic planning, marketing, board development, fundraising, certification programs or equipment and software updates

MINI GRANTS

Does your organization have a smaller project, short-term program, or unplanned opportunity that requires immediate funding or seed money that will lead to a large impact? Consider applying for a mini grant.

Mini grants also present a compelling option for newer nonprofit organizations, or those who haven't previously applied for a grant award from the Foundation.

Requests may be up to \$5,000.

CRISIS GRANTS

Crisis grants are intended to help organizations who are facing a sudden expense(s) for which they were unable to prepare for and could quickly affect their ability to carry out their core mission.

Requests may be up to \$5,000.
