5 points maximum per question

- 1. How well does this application examine the underlying causes that are creating a local need and seek a solution to address that need?
- 2. How well does this application represent a proactive rather than reactive approach? Is it culturally relevant, change-oriented or problem-solving in nature?
- 3. Does this project/program have a broad reach, as represented by the number of people affected, or the depth of impact to those who are involved or affected?
- 4. How well-defined is the plan to measure and report on the success of the program according to the stated objectives?
- 5. Does the amount of the request seem in line with the potential benefit?
- 6. How accurately did the project budget detail the funding and expenses?
